Rock Climbing Instructor Training

You will need to be registered for the award with Mountain Training and have filled out your online logbook (DLOG) with your experience so far.

To register with Mountain Training you must meet the prerequisites they set out

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have an interest in rock climbing
- Be an experienced climber
- Have led at least 15 trad routes, 5 sport routes and 15 indoor routes
- Be a member of a mountaineering council

Day 2 – Personal climbing, personal abseiling and top roping

Day 3 – Bottom roping, group abseiling and problem solving

The order of the days may change due to weather.
